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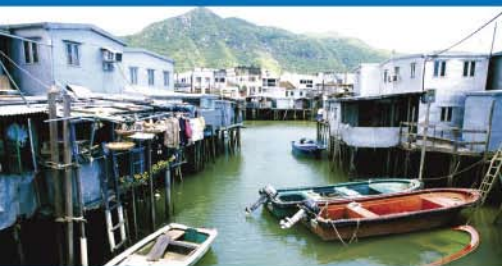
Frequency: Every Friday

Tai O Ecotour Often called the “Venice of Hong Kong”, the tiny village of Tai O is not only a relaxing getaway from the hustle and bustle of Asia’s world city, but also a treasured cultural and heritage site.

Until recently, most of the inhabitants relied on fishing for their livelihood and “main street” was actually a creek, which they crossed by means of a hand-pulled rope ferry (replaced by a steel bridge in 1996). Unique to Hong Kong, the villagers live in houses on stilts.
