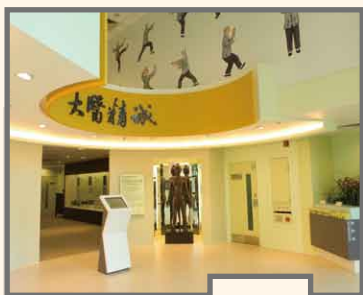


6. Chinese Medicine Class



Learn the age-old secrets of Chinese medicine! Contemporary Chinese medicine represents the theories and experiences of Chinese physicians dating back five millennia.

Hong Kong Baptist University set up the Dr and Mrs Hung

Hin Shiu Museum of Chinese Medicine with the vision to introduce the history of Traditional Chinese Medicine.

The Museum in the School of Chinese Medicine Building houses around a hundred exhibits from past dynasties to the modern age and exhibits over 6,000 specimens of Chinese *Materia Medica*.

Participants will be able to gain basic knowledge about Traditional Chinese Medicine, the purposes of some widely used herbal medicines and weigh herbs from a traditional compartmental cabinet for Chinese medicines (*Bai Zi Gui*).
