10. Dr Sun Yat-sen Museum Guided Tour

As a revolutionary pioneer in modern China, Dr Sun Yat-sen is renowned for transforming China from a monarchy to a republic. The revolutionary ideologies of Dr Sun were shaped while he was receiving his early education in Hong Kong.



This guided tour takes you through the museum (see page 32) covering his life and times in Hong Kong. Dr Sun Yat-sen is renowned as the revolutionary leader who succeeded in overthrowing the Qing Dynasty and the two-thousand-odd years of Chinese autocracy in 1911.



He was proclaimed the Provisional President of the Republic of China in 1912. After the tour, visitors can gain further insights into this great man by walking the Dr Sun Yat-sen Historical Trail that traces his activities and highlights various landmarks while he was living in Hong Kong. Information plaques are located at each station to facilitate your exploration.

- 📍 Entrance of the Permanent Exhibition Gallery on 2/F, Dr Sun Yat-sen Museum, 7 Castle Road, Central District, Hong Kong
- 🚇 MTR Central Station, Exit D2. Walk along Queen's Road Central to take the Central-Mid-Levels Escalator to Caine Road, turn right and walk westwards for around 5 minutes.
- 🕒 3:30pm – 4:30pm (Saturday)
- 💰 Guided tour free of charge; admission to Dr Sun Yat-sen Museum* HK\$10 adult; HK\$5 student/disabled/senior (aged 60 or above); HK\$7 per person for groups of 20 or more. Free entry for children under 4. Free on Wednesday, the anniversaries of Dr Sun's birth (12 November) and death (12 March)
