Monthly Visitor Arrivals First Exceed a Million in Three Years Number of "Hong Kong Goodies" Outlets Doubled to 3,000 MTR Corporation Gives Out Offers of HK\$20 million+ to Visitors

The Hong Kong Tourism Board (HKTB) announced that Hong Kong saw a provisional visitor arrival of 1.462 million in February, a triple of that in January. The figure first exceeded one million since the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic in February 2020 and is equivalent to about 30% of that before the pandemic. Among the arrivals, Mainland visitors shows a significant increase. Other short-haul visitors mainly came from Southeast Asia. Share of leisure visitors is also on a continuous rise.

Starting from April, the number of outlets offering "Hong Kong Goodies" will also be doubled from the current 1,500 to around 3,000. Visitors can redeem the coupons for the latest rewards, or welcome drinks at selected bars, restaurants and hotels, or offers at various attractions, retail and dining outlets to enjoy a HK\$100 discount off their purchases.

Mr Dane Cheng, HKTB Executive Director, said, "With more enriched offers, the 'Hong Kong Goodies' allow visitors not only to enjoy a more convenient and cosier trip, but also to explore the city's unique experiences.
