## **Hong Kong Tourism Board Thanks Dr Pang Yiu-kai for His Contribution to the Tourism Industry and Welcomes the Appointment of Dr Peter Lam as Chairman**

Regarding the Hong Kong SAR Government's appointment of Dr Peter Lam Kin-ngok to succeed Dr Pang Yiu-kai as the Chairman of the Hong Kong Tourism Board (HKTB) with effect from 1 April 2025, HKTB expresses its heartfelt gratitude to Dr Pang for his contribution to Hong Kong's tourism industry and welcomes the appointment of Dr Lam as Chairman.

I am very grateful to the Government, the travel trade, my fellow HKTB members and the team for the support they have given me throughout the years. I will continue to work closely with HKTB team to promote 'Hong Kong Super March' and fully support work of HKTB going forward. I wish HKTB and Dr Lam every success."

HKTB also extends its warmest welcome to its incoming Chairman, Dr Peter Lam. Dr Lam had been a member of HKTB since 2007 and served as Chairman from 2013 to 2019.
