## Kai Tak Sports Park



### Kai Tak Stadium

Accommodates up to 50,000 spectators, ideal for large-scale events ranging from sports competitions to cultural festivities and outdoor concerts.



### Kai Tak Arena

The indoor venue accommodates up to 10,000 spectators and is designed for major international sports tournaments and community events.



### Kai Tak Youth Sports Ground

Features a 5,000-seat capacity and a world-class multi-lane athletics track to IAAF standards.



### Kai Tak Mall

Spanning 700,000 square feet and home to over 200 stores along with diverse culinary options and entertainment attractions.
